RULES AND CONDITIONS OF ENTRY 2025

Condition of entry, that exhibitors agree to follow all rules and also rules within the SSADL Showing & Dressage Rule Book 2025.

- 1. All ponies/horses must have their passports with them; random checks may be carried out. Any equine found to be without a valid passport will be disqualified.
- 2. This show is Open to Members and Non-Members of SSADL, NO QUALIFICATION REQUIRED UNLESS IN THE LIHS/RIHS & MEMBERS CHALLENGE & SENIOR OF THE YEAR QUALIFIERS
- 3. <u>SHOWING CLASSES</u>, All ponies and horses must be 15 years and over & Home Produced. <u>DRESSAGE CLASSES</u> All ponies & horses MUST be 4 years of age and over. Classes are dived in the age categories With the exception to RESS classes.
- 4. SSADL and Onley Complex Grounds will not accept liability for any accident, death, injury, loss, damage or illness to either spectators, horses/ponies, riders/handlers or their property, however caused, whether competing or not, whilst on the showground.
- 5. SSADL DIRECTORS RESERVES THE RIGHT TO REFUSE ENTRY TO ANY PERSON WITHOUT EXPLANATION.
- 6. <u>THE COMMITTEE RESERVE THE RIGHT TO AMEND, ALTER, CANCEL, SPLIT OR AMALGAMATE ANY CLASS ANY DAY , OR SUBSTITUTE</u> <u>ANY JUDGE AT ANY TIME.</u>
- 7. Anyone found behaving inappropriately or using inappropriate language towards any judge or show official, will be disqualified.
- 8. The judge's decision is always final and binding. Confrontation with a judge in or around the ring is strictly forbidden.
- 9. Same handler/rider and pony/horse combination competing MUST be the same as on the SSADL membership card.
- 10. No substitution entries will be permitted. NO MOVING OF CLASSES
- 11. Anyone handling a pony/horse at this show **must wear a hat or cap in the ring**. Anyone riding a horse/pony at this show anywhere on the ground must wear a hard hat. It is **mandatory** for competitors up to and including the age of 16 to wear correctly secured riding hats of current British Standards.
- 12. In all other day classes, it is mandatory for competitors up to and including the age of 16 to wear correctly secured riding hats of current British Standards IN ALL SUPREME CHAMPIONSHIPS AFTERNOON/EVENING PERFORMANCES EVENING ATTIRE IS ACCEPTED. Competitors 16 years of age and under must wear the correctly secured riding hat.
- 13. Entry Fees will NOT be refunded under any circumstances. The Directors reserve the right to refuse any entry without explanation
- 14. Unruly animals deemed to be a danger to any persons shall be asked to leave the ring. Any pony/horse showing signs of illness or in distress will be asked to leave the ring
- 15. All dogs must always be kept on a lead. Please clean up any mess.
- 16. All stallions must be bitted and handled at all times by a person 16 years of age and over.
- Perpetual Trophies must be signed for and a refundable deposit paid before trophies are released. Trophies to be returned by 1st July 2025 to Clare Frost : Suncrest, 119 High Lane, Brown Edge, Stoke-on-Trent, Staffordshire, ST6 8RT. Some trophies may require a copy of competitors house insurance before being released.
- 18. SSADL HOME PRODUCED RULES Apply see SSADL RULE BOOK FOR TERMS AND CONDIDTIONS
- 19. Riders or handlers cannot exhibit under any judge if they have kept ponies/horses at livery/stud or have leased, loaned, or produced by the judge since 1st January the previous year.
- 20. No spurs or spur bands are permitted within the showing classes and showing championships (With the exception to Adult side saddle riders where the spur band, blunt or dummy is allowed).
- 21. Spurs are allowed in the Dressage Classes to competitors 16 years of age and over. Full dressage rules are displayed in the SSADL rule book or go to www.seniorsshowinganddressage.co.uk
- 22. No galloping/Canter extension, no wearing of jewellery with the exception to the earing used by competitors with health problems. foals will not be permitted in the show ring . in hand classes minimum age of handler 11 years. Stallions riders/handlers to be 16 years and over.
- 24. Any fall of a pony/horse and /or rider/handler will result in disqualification. Riders will not be allowed to re-mount .
- 25. IMPORTANT : Please read all aspects of the 2025 SSADL rule book BEFORE entering the Championship Show.,..
- 26. Late entries will not be allowed in the ring once the command to TROT has been given.
- 27. No competitor will be judged if they have not completed the initial go round unless the judge agrees, then the competitor will go non competitive and will not be marked or placed. Competitors cannot leave the show ring without the judge's permission.
